***WARABI CITY'S 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY***

**WHEREAS,** El Dorado County congratulates Warabi City, Japan on their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of incorporation as a city; and

**WHEREAS,** Warabi City, Japan and El Dorado County California, U.S.A. have maintained a "Sister City" relationship for the past thirty-four (34) years; and

**WHEREAS,** During the past thirty-four (34) years El Dorado County and Warabi City have enhanced their mutual understanding and friendship through the Sister-City exchange and experience; and

**WHEREAS,** El Dorado County has a historical connection to Warabi City, Japan through the Japanese citizens who relocated to the Gold Hill area in El Dorado County to establish a tea and silk farm one mile from the gold discovery site in 1869; and

**WHEREAS,** The 1851 circa drawing of Sutter's Mill in Coloma, where gold was discovered, represents that connection with the Japanese citizens.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors extends their congratulations to our Sister City, Warabi City for 50 years incorporated as a city.
