



RESOLUTION No. 237-99

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, California Food and Agriculture Code Chapter 9, Article 6.5, Vertebrate Pest Control Research Sections 6025 and 6027.5 gives to counties the authority to enact local ordinances regarding recovery of costs related to the provision of pesticides to members of the public; and

WHEREAS, the public has demonstrated a need for provision of such materials; and

WHEREAS, the presence of pest populations presents a danger to the public health and welfare; and

WHEREAS, increased populations of such pests present a clear and present danger to agricultural crops; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures is able to provide rodenticides at cost; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures is able to provide gopher bait machines to the public at cost; and

WHEREAS, said Code and County Ordinance Code provisions authorize the Board to set fees for reimbursement of costs related to provision of said rodenticides to the public; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has determined it is both necessary and in the public interest to establish county registration fees by ordinance at Chapter 5.16 of the County Ordinance Code for pest control related activities; and

WHEREAS, Sections 11704, 11734, 11923, 12034, 15204 and Chapter 9, Article 6.5, Sections 6025 and 6027.5 of the California Food and Agriculture Code and Section 1695 (b) of the California Labor Code empowers the Board to establish said fees; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures receives requests for services and/or materials from members of the public; and

WHEREAS, said Code and County Ordinance Code provisions authorize the Board to set fee levels by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has allowed for adjustment factors in setting fees utilizing the cost of living adjustment (COLA) percent adopted by El Dorado County for County employees to be applied in order to assure that the base year fee and subsequent revenue is neither exceeding nor falling behind the actual cost or established percentage; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of El Dorado Irrigation District has set a reduced rate for water for small farmers called Small Farms Irrigation Rate; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Directors has agreed to accept certification by the Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures as to whether individuals applying for Small Farms Irrigation water rate meet criteria as set by said Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures performs certification and inspection services related to the Certified Producers' Certification Program; and

WHEREAS, said Code and County ordinance Code provisions authorize the Board of Supervisors to set fees for said inspection services provided by resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado, that the Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures is hereby authorized to charge fees as set forth in Attachment A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that fees as shown in Attachment A shall be reviewed annually by the Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures and revised in accordance with Board of Supervisors' Policy, County Fee Policy Automatic Adjustment Factors Cost Analysis; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution will, upon adoption by the Board of Supervisors, supercede Resolution No. 15-93.

RESOLUTION No. 300-94

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, California Business and Professions Code Section 12240 gives to counties the authority to enact local ordinances regarding weighing and measuring devices to offset the costs of inspecting such devices; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado has enacted Ordinance No. 4347, thereby amending the El Dorado County Code Chapter 5.54 entitled Commercial Weighing and Measuring Instruments; and

WHEREAS, state law prescribes a statutory limit to such fees which may be charged; and

WHEREAS, said statutory limit has been reviewed and incorporated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that the fees to be charged for the registration of weighing and measuring devices shall be as follows:

- 1-3 devices - \$40 per location
- 4-9 devices - \$80 per location
- 10-19 devices- \$120 per location
- 20-25 devices- \$160 per location
- Over 25 devices- \$200 per location

Notwithstanding this schedule, the annual registration fee shall be \$3.50 for vapor meters per year at a single meter

location. The annual registration fee for electric meters and vapor meters in mobile home parks, recreational vehicle parks and apartment complexes, where the owner of the park or complex owns and is responsible for the utility meters, shall be sixty dollars (\$60.00) per park or complex and a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) per device per space or apartment.

The annual registration fee for one (1) to three (3) hanging, computer, platform, or counter scale(s) used on a seasonal basis shall be twenty dollars (\$20) per year per location. The annual registration fee for seasonal hanging, computer, or counter scales brought to the Office of the Sealer of Weights and Measures by the owner shall be ten dollars (\$10) per device.

The annual registration fee for weighing devices, other than livestock and motor truck scales, with capacities of 20,000 pounds or greater, shall be two-hundred dollars (\$200) per device.

The registration fee for motor truck scales shall be one-hundred dollars (\$100) per device.

The registration fee for livestock scales with capacities of 20,000 pounds or greater, shall be one-hundred dollars (\$100) per device, except that the fee for not more than three devices at a single location shall be one-hundred dollars (\$100).

The fees established herein shall be effective thirty (30) days from December 13, 1994 (the effective date of Ordinance No.

4347).

RESOLUTION No. 196-77

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES TO ADOPT
A SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE INSPECTION, TESTING
AND CERTIFICATION OF NON-COMMERCIAL WEIGHING AND MEASURING DEVICES

WHEREAS, the Director of Weights and Measures is not required by law to inspect, test or certify non-commercial weighing and measuring devices; and

WHEREAS, Section 12210(b) of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California authorizes the Director of Weights and Measures to inspect, test and certify non-commercial and other weighing and measuring devices, when directed by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, it is a convenience and an aid to the owners and operators of such non-commercial devices to have them inspected, tested and certified by the Director,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes and directs that the Director of Weights and Measures may inspect, test and certify non-commercial weighing and measuring and other devices, pursuant to Section 12210(b) of the Business and Professions Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Director shall provide a form for the request of such services, and that the schedule of fees authorized by the California Department of Measurement Standards for the performance of such services as may be amended from time to time, shall be the fees charged for such services.
