

- A. No children live within 50 feet of the TIGER LILY site. Only 2 children live on the top of the hill (about 250 feet from site) 3 children live down on the side of the hill (about double of above distance). Property of tower site will have an 8 foot high fence around it and is to be gated. Plus, there will be a 8 foot cedar fence around the tower its self. There are no educational sites within 50 feet of the tower site.
- B In the letter, Ms. PEERMAN states that AT&T has to travel through her parcel to get the to the tower site. The roads to be used to go to the tower do NOT cross, touch, or border the PEERMAN parcel.

The roads that will be used by AT&T to reach the tower site have been used continuously for over <u>40 years</u>. There have been no motor vehicle accidents caused by road conditions. We have had one drunk driver flip his car off the bridge into the stream.


Well drilling rigs, fire trucks, cranes, FEDEX, UPS, moving vans, trucks loaded with long beams and construction materials, and etc. have successfully navigated the road with no accidents.

- C. As the crow flies, the closest neighbor to the proposed tower site is the HALLOCKs' house, at about 250 feet away. None of the "fantastic views" from the top of the hill will be impacted by the proposed tower.
- D No construction work at the top of the hill has impacted the presence of wildlife. The animals return soon after the vehicles leave.

To whom it may concern:

This email is in regard to the proposed cell tower site located off of Victory Mine rd in Placerville also known as the Tiger Lily cell tower site. I am in opposition to the proposed tower site.

The proposed tower site is a couple hundred feet from our home. If approved, we will be forced to sell our home as I won't raise my young family in the shadow of a cell tower due to associated health risks. My children's health is most important to me, but health risks alone aren't enough to deny a tower apparently. So, a few other reasons are: 1. We currently have four bars of LTE cell service already making the tower unnecessary. 2: There are other sites in the local area that would cover the same demographic without affecting residential neighborhoods/families as the other sites are located on vacant parcels. 3. We have a "million-dollar view", those aesthetics would be degraded as well as our peaceful setting in the country. 4. Property value loss due to the tower could be up to 20% according to online research and local real estate agents. We work too hard for our money to just give up 20% of our homes value for a useless tower.

Further more the "easement" labeled in the site plan has been illegally deeded by the property owner at 5411 Victory Mine Rd (address where the tower would be located). The "easement" is not an easement at all, but rather an extension of our driveway. I do not consent to the use of this, in fact it is involved in a litigation currently.

El Dorado county is where I want to raise my family due to the friendly and tight knit sense of community, excellent schools, proximity to both mountains and ocean, ag/farming opportunities, and for the many recreational opportunities the area offers. I am also a small business owner of a business based in Placerville. Not only do I own and operate my business, I have a second job based in Roseville. I chose to commute back and forth because I feel it is worth the extra effort in order to raise my family in Placerville. I will be forced to leave all this behind if this tower gets approved and built.

Please do not approve this tower site. I know there are alternate sites available that would serve the same number of households with little to no effect to others in the area.



There are many health concerns with these towers. It seems reasonable that it not be placed next to homes with families not wanting to take risks with their family's health.


What rights do the homeowners have to secure a safe environment for their children?




