

Joe's Skatepark

<u>Rules and Regulations</u>

- 1. Use at own risk. This is a non-supervised facility
- 2. All persons entering, using, or remaining in any skatepark must wear a shirt while on skatepark property.
- 3. No person may bring structures, obstacles, or other materials, such as ramps or jumps, into the skate-park.
- 4. Smoking, tobacco, drugs, and alcoholic beverages are prohibited anywhere at or near the skatepark.
- 5. It shall be unlawful to engage in graffiti, tagging, or other defacing (such as the placing of stickers or decals) of skatepark property or the property of others, as more specifically proscribed in the County Graffiti Abatement Ordinance.
- 6. Except for authorized guide dogs and service animals, animals are prohibited in the skatepark.
- 7. Glass containers are prohibited anywhere at or near the skatepark.
- 8. Recklessness, horseplay, foul language, vandalism, and disrespect to staff and/or other skatepark users is prohibited.
- 9. No person shall skate on curbs, fences, railings, walls, benches, tables, and/or driveways of the County-owned area surrounding the skatepark. Skatepark users shall be considerate of nearby businesses and residents in the surrounding neighborhood.
- 10. No skating is allowed at the skatepark when the skatepark surfaces are wet.
- **11.** Do not use the facility if any hazardous conditions exists. El Dorado County is not responsible for any lost property.
- 12. Use of the skatepark is not permitted when the facility is closed. The park will be closed for maintenance, when it is raining, snowing or when the surface is otherwise unsafe to use.
- 13. Report all violations, unsafe conditions, graffiti, vandalism, or maintenance concerns to 530 621-5890. For emergencies CALL 911.
- 14. Persons failing to comply with these regulations shall be subject to citation for an infraction or misdemeanor, subjecting the offender to a fine of not more than \$500 and imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, expulsion from the park, and/or may have their skateboard, skates or other personal property seized.
