- Tape Library
 - Maintains all of the County mission critical mainframe data (Financial, Property, Recorder, Land Management and all mainframe programs)
 - Device is critical backup to system for off-site storage for use in the event of a datacenter disaster
- · Key Decision Points
 - Acquired July 2000
 - Useful Life of 3 Years Actual Life 8+ Years
 - Obsolete Technology Replacement parts are scarce & rebuilt

Information Technologies

- Key Decision Points Continued
 - Purchased through StorageTek
 - Internal Data representation is proprietary to StorageTek – Incompatible with IBM
 - StorageTek bought by Sun Microsystems
 - · StorageTek products are a secondary product line
 - · Technical support lacking & code updates irregular
 - Hardware support is good, however there is only one technician
 - · Business relationship has declined

Information Technologies

- · Key Decision Points Continued
 - If the device had a traumatic failure there would be no way to transfer the data from one format to another
 - Requires "soft landing". Time to migrate data to a new device before system failure occurs
 - Current Maintenance expires February 28, 2009. Current annual cost of \$37,500; however cost anticipated to increase upon renewal

Information Technologies

- · Recommendation:
 - List price quotes range from \$225K to \$300K.
 - Recommend IT initiate a Request for Bid process to get accurate pricing
 - Recommend Board consideration after State budget impacts and completion of County budget.
