Findings

Based on the review and analysis of this project by staff and affected agencies, and supported by discussion in the staff report and evidence in the record, the following findings can be made:

FINDINGS FOR APPROVAL

1.0 CEQA Findings

1.1 This project has been found to be Categorically Exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to Section 15304 of the CEQA Guidelines stating that "Minor temporary use of land having negligible or no permanent effects on the environment, including carnivals, sale of Christmas trees, etc".

2.0 Administrative Findings

2.1 The project has been reviewed in accordance with the El Dorado County Code and it has been determined that the project is consistent with §5.32 and the proposed use is not considered detrimental to the public health, safety, and welfare, or injurious to the neighborhood, based on the conclusions contained in the staff report.

Conditions of Approval

1. The subject Site Plan Review and §5.32 permit approval is based and limited to compliance with the project description and Conditions of Approval set forth below. Any deviations from the project description, exhibits, or conditions must be reviewed and approved by the County for Conformity with this approval. Deviations may require approved changes to the permit and/or further environmental review. Deviations without the above-described approval will constitute a violation of permit approval.

The project, as approved, shall consist of the following:

An outdoor music festival on Saturday, June 6, 2009 at Henningsen-Lotus County Park, APN 006-011-42, during the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Set up to take place Friday, June 5, 2009 from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Clean up to begin after the show is completed on Saturday, June 6, 2008, and is to be completed by Monday June 9, 2008.

Parking will be located at the following APNs: 006-011-75, 006-011-76, 088-460-04, 006-341-14, and 089-030-23. The remainder of the parking facilities are on parcels out of the County's jurisdiction.

No amplified music or sound checks are to be projected after 10:00 p.m. during set up and the festival date.

- 2. Traffic Control: The applicant shall provide a Traffic Control and Parking Management Plan that indicates all measures to be used. This plan shall include at a minimum:
 - a. Site Plan showing ingress/egress points and circulation for the festival.
 - b. Name and contact information for person in charge of traffic control and parking responsible for responding to complaints on the days of the event.
 - c. Location of all traffic control personnel on a site plan or vicinity map.
 - d. Location of all traffic control and directional signs on a site plan or vicinity map.
 - e. Location of all parking lots, parking capacity of each, and the sequence of use.
 - f. Location of all shuttle stops and the proposed shuttle routes.
 - g. Emergency access ways.

This Traffic Control and Parking Management Plan shall be submitted to DOT for review and approval prior to issuance of the outdoor music festival permit.

El Dorado County Fire Protection District

- 3. Site/inspection review fee is \$ 150.00
- 4. Fire District inspection is required prior to event.
- 5. 20 foot fire lanes will be maintained in parking lots and on all road ways.
- 6. No parking on Bassi Road.
- 7. All concession and event tents will be inspected by the Fire District and meet State Fire Marshal flammability standards.
- 8. Fire extinguishers will be required. Location of extinguishers will be determined during inspection prior to the event.
