## Re: Welfare fraud investigator positions should not be eliminated

## Ladies and Gentlemen:

I am writing as a concerned citizen to recommend that the Board reject a proposal to eliminate all welfare fraud investigator positions in the county (the county welfare department's Special Investigations Unit or SIU).

I understand that a proposal has been made to eliminate the entire SIU by eliminating all of the 3.5 investigator positions and reassigning the SIU support staff to other support staff jobs in the county welfare office.

I strongly recommend that the Board reject this proposal. I think it would be unwise for the county to attempt to economize by eliminating SIU when the function of this unit is to monitor and reduce public spending on aid programs.

Fraud investigation serves an important law enforcement function by ensuring the fiscal soundness and integrity of public aid programs. Fraud investigation is crucial to ensure that benefits are provided only to eligible persons; to recover benefits that were fraudulently obtained; and to disqualify a recipient who has lied to the county to get benefits from receiving benefits in the future.

It is likely that welfare fraud will increase if the county has no mechanism in place to investigate or deter fraud.

I urge the Board to protect this important law enforcement function and not allow the county welfare department's Special Investigations Unit to be eliminated.
