Subject: $\quad$ Silva Valley Parkway Class I and II Bike Lanes Project, PW 17-31203, CIP No. 72310 Road Closure Authorization Memo for Silva Valley Parkway

This project consists of Base Bid (Schedule A) and Additive Bid (Schedule B). Schedule A includes paving approximately 5,800 linear feet concrete and asphalt Class I bike path east of Silva Valley Parkway, from Harvard Way to Appian Way. The construction of the Class I bike path includes construction of a retaining wall, drainage facilities, rock slope protection, erosion control, signing and striping. Schedule A also includes minor roadway widening, slurry seal and restriping to provide a Class II bike lane along southbound and northbound Silva Valley Parkway from Green Valley Road to Appian Way (approximately 5,000 linear feet). Schedule B includes slurry seal, signing and restriping to provide a Class II bike lane along southbound Silva Valley Parkway from Appian Way to Harvard Way (approximately 5,800 linear feet).

This Project (Schedule A and Schedule B) is a sixty (60) working day Project. Silva Valley Parkway, between Harvard Way and Appian Way, will be fully closed to traffic for thirty-six (36) hours during a weekend (Saturday 7:00 am to Sunday 7:00 pm) shown on the attached Detour Plan. This closure will require road closure signs and Portable Changeable Message Sign (PCMS) placement on both sides of the Project per the attached Detour Plan. Access for local residents and visitors, as well as emergency personnel and law enforcement will be via detour to Harvard Way, El Dorado Hills Boulevard, and Green Valley Road per the attached Detour Plan. County Department of Transportation will notify the public of this road closure via the County website, a press release, and PCMS boards at least one week in advance of starting work.

The dates of the closure will be approximately from July 28, 2018 through July 29, 2018. The actual dates will be confirmed with the above referenced notifications once the Contract is awarded, weather conditions suitable for the Project are verified, and the work dates are known. The Contractor's insurance certification will be submitted to Risk Management with the Contract Package.
