

PROCLAMATION

Of the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado In Recognition of Chaplain Tim Thompson

WHEREAS, Chaplain Tim Thompson has provided over three decades of spiritual aid, comfort and support to law enforcement personnel, active military personnel, military veterans, patients at Marshall Hospital and those in our community who are affected by a crisis as well as those who simply seek an understanding friend; and,

WHEREAS, Lt. Colonel Thompson served his country as a member of the United States Navy, the Oregon Army National Guard and United States Army's Chaplain Corp where he would support and comfort soldiers and their family members during mobilizations as part of Desert Storm and the Global War on Terror; and,

WHEREAS, Chaplain Tim Thompson formed the Sierra Law Enforcement Chaplaincy in 1990, initially to serve the El Dorado County Sheriff's Department but has expanded to now include services to the men, women and family members of the El Dorado County District Attorney's Office, the City of Placerville Police Department, the City of Folsom Police Department, the El Dorado County Probation Department, the California Highway Patrol Placerville Office and the United States Forest Service; and,

WHEREAS, in establishing the Sierra Law Enforcement Chaplaincy and through his leadership in service, Chaplain Tim Thompson has and continues to make a difference in the lives of those who serve and protect our community and for those who seek spiritual solace.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado does hereby recognize and honor Chaplain Tim Thompson for his selfless dedication to serve the men and women who serve our country and community, their loved ones, and the countless residents throughout the County of El Dorado who have received comfort and support due to his leadership and vision.
