WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors exercises the authority established by Section 8333 of the Streets and Highways Code, which authorizes the Board of Supervisors to summarily vacate public service easements by Resolution adopted in accordance with Section 8335 of the Streets and Highways code; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 1960, Tahoe Paradise Homes, a Corporation, irrevocably offered for dedication a public utility easement on Lot 7 as shown on the final map of, "*Tahoe Paradise Unit No. 18*", recorded in Book C of Subdivisions at Page 50, in the County of El Dorado, Recorder's Office; and

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado has received an application from *Warren L. Johnson and Patricia J. Johnson Revocable Living Trust* and the *Nancy King-Walter Trust*, the legal owners of the south half of Lot 7 in "*Tahoe Paradise Unit No. 18*", requesting that the County of El Dorado vacate the subject easement, on said property, identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 034-402-13; and

WHEREAS, AT&T, Souwest Gas Corporation, South Tahoe Public Utility District and Liberty Energy have not used said easement for the purpose for which it was dedicated and find no present or future need exists for subject easement and do not object to its vacation, and to that end, have all issued letters to that effect; and

WHEREAS, the Surveyor's Office has determined that the easement herein described in Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B and made a part thereof has not been used for the purpose for which it was dedicated and has no objection; and

WHEREAS, all other existing easements shall remain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that from and after the date this Resolution is recorded, said offer for the portion of the public utility easement, described in Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B, is terminated and abandoned and no longer constitutes an offer for easement. All that certain real property located in the County of El Dorado, Unincorporated Area, State of California, more particularly described as follows:


