

Proclamation of the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado To Recognize Marshall Medical Center

WHEREAS, a group of local citizens saw a great need for hospital care in El Dorado County in the 1950's and came together to build a new hospital;

WHEREAS, Marshall Hospital opened its doors in 1959, originally as a 30-bed facility;

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical center has grown to a 122-bed acute care facility with 18 clinic sites around the Western Slope of El Dorado County;

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical center is overseen by a volunteer Board of Directors who maintain Marshall Medical's financial stability and oversee strategy and growth;

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical is one of the largest employers in the County, with over 1,600 employees on the payroll;

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center has received numerous designations and awards for patient care, including a "Baby Friendly Hospital" designation by Unicef and the World Health Organization;

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center recently received a 5-star rating – the highest possible – by the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare services, and Marshall Medical ranks among the top 7% of hospitals in Northern California for Overall Hospital Quality;

WHEREAS, Marshall Medical Center has now earned the Healthgrades Outstanding Patient Experience Award for 2018, ranking among the top 10% of all hospitals in the nation for Outstanding Patient Experience;

AND WHEREAS, the providers and staff of Marshall Medical Center have made these designations and awards possible through their expert and caring service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Board of Supervisors of El Dorado County send congratulations and wish continued success to Marshall Medical Center.
