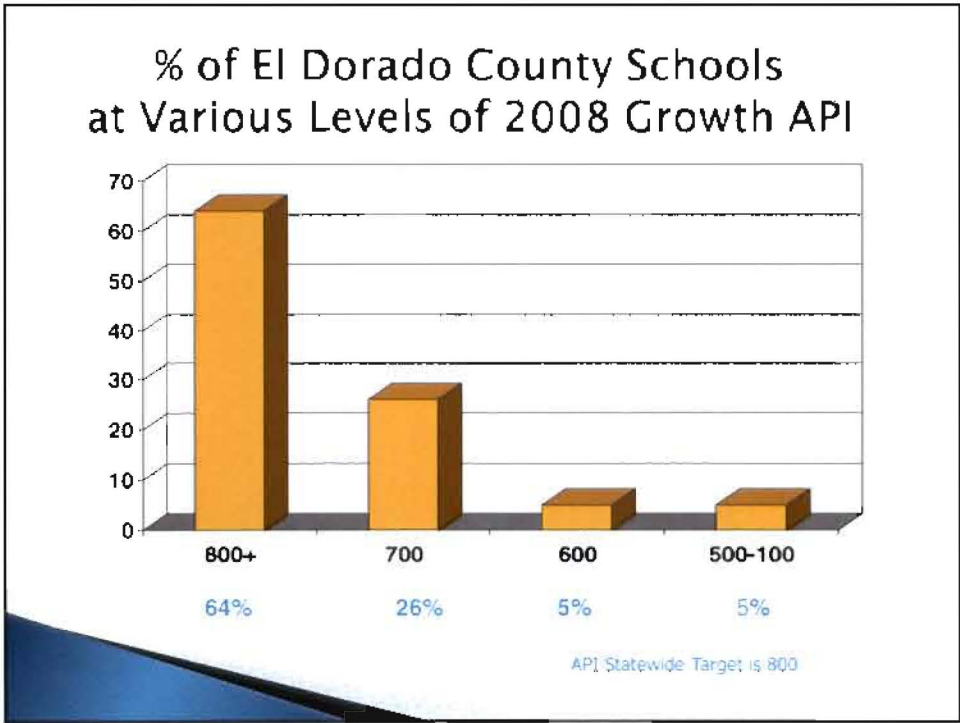
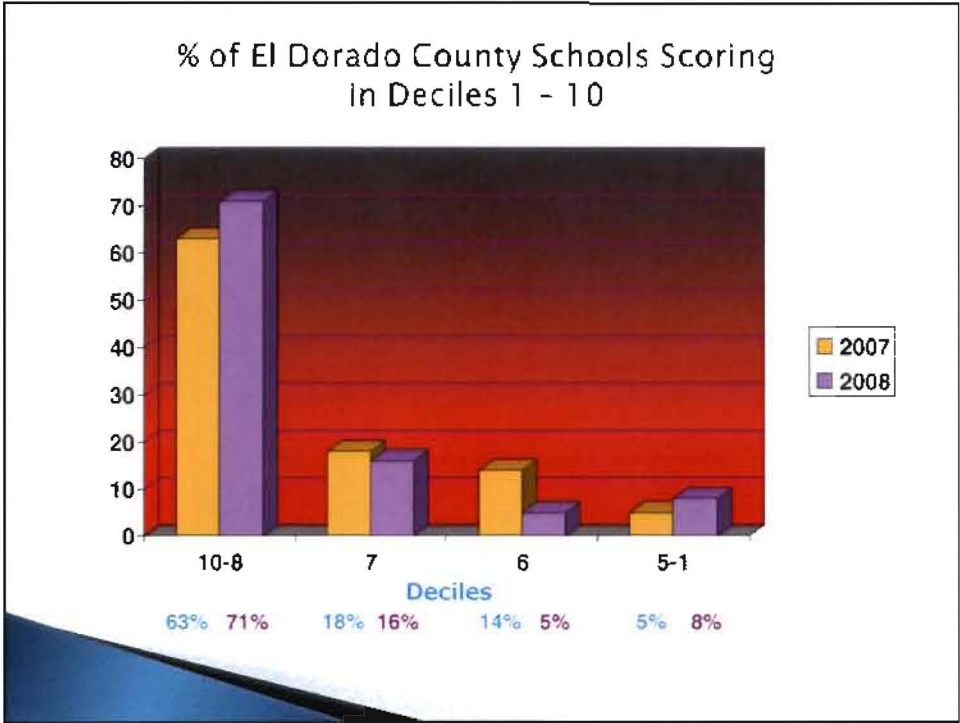

El Dorado County API School Ranking

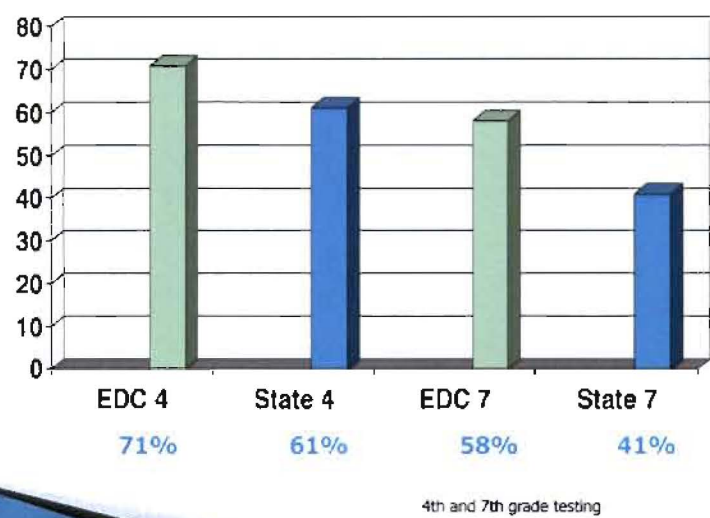
- All schools in California are given an API Score

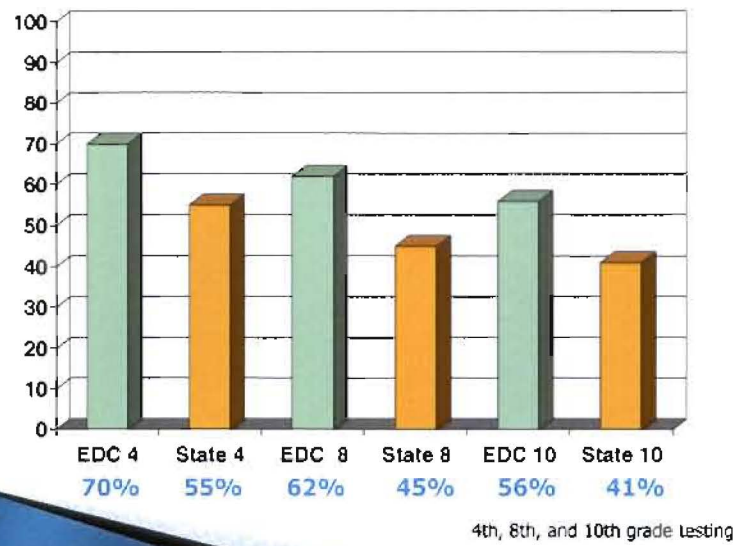
