Dear Members of the Board of Supervisors,

The El Dorado County Association of Realtors (EDCAR) has reviewed the Summary Report and Analysis of FY 2017-18 Charter Review Committee Recommendations and offers the following positions for your consideration.

A. EDCAR supports the Charter Review Committees recommendations to:

1. Repeal / remove term limits for Members of the Board of Supervisors (currently limited to 2 consecutive terms). Should you not support the repeal of term limits, we ask you to approve an alternative for the addition of one more four-year term, allowing for three consecutive four year terms.
2. Not make any changes to Charter Sections 210 and 301, that would change the title of the CAO to CEO.
3. Modify Charter Section 502, according to the recommendations of the Chief Administrative Officer.

B. EDCAR does not support the Charter Review Committees recommendations to:

1. Revise Section 204 of the Charter, regarding compensation of Supervisors.
2. Add the words "state law" to Charter section 304, it is unnecessary.
3. Make "all non-constitutional department heads appointed" officers, as opposed to elected officers.
