Gov Announces \$10 Million in Grants for Green Jobs

On May 1, the California Recovery Task Force announced the availability of up to \$10 million in Recovery Act funding for job training grants within the Governor's newly created California Green Job Corps.

Through a Solicitation for Proposal (SFP) process that begins May 1, 2009, local Workforce Investment Boards and Community Colleges can apply for the grants, with each applicant eligible to apply for a maximum of \$1 million per application. All proposals must be received by California's Employment Development Department no later than 3 p.m. on May 26, 2009. DOE WAP ARRA Contract Updates

CSD's objective is to release the contracts no later then June 1st with the expectation that the contracts must be executed by your agency no later then June 23rd for full execution no later then June 30th.

Fully executed means that the agency has signed the contract and the CSD has signed the contract no later then June 30th. We are requesting that you prepare your Board by advising them that it may be necessary to hold an emergency board meeting to ensure that the contract is signed and sent back to CSD by June 23rd.

To facilitate the board resolution process, it is CSD's goal to release the

draft allocation spreadsheet along with assigned contract numbers by the end of this week.

The initial DOE WAP ARRA contract will be limited to start up activities to include costs associated with administration, liability insurance, outreach, training and technical assistance, vehicle and equipment costs, vehicle insurance, and workers' compensation. The contract will *not* cover costs for direct program activities, intake or health and safety.
