

Proclamation of the Board of Supervisors Of The County of El Dorado

Proclaiming the Week of June 18-21, 2009 "El Dorado County Fair Week"

WHEREAS, the 2009 theme for the Fair, "Hooves to Horsepower", highlights the last 150 years in El Dorado County, with blacksmiths, antique cars, horses, bucking bulls and the annual wheelbarrow races, to name only a few; and,

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair continues to encourage participation and recognition of the diverse accomplishments of the County's youth through innovative partnership of the El Dorado County Office of Education, Future Farmers of America, University of California Cooperative Extension and the Fair Association; and,

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair enriches the public's knowledge of the world around them through educational exhibits such as the "Fair's of Old" Exhibit, the Fair's own "Growing Farm," the Jr. Livestock Auction, and the many demonstrations given by the Master Gardeners; and,

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fair fosters increased cultural awareness and appreciation of the arts by providing a venue for the exhibition of dance, music and art, as well as an "Author's Porch" filled with local writers and the Antique Carousel Exhibit.
