OVERVIEW OF BUDGET 2009-2010

Positions eliminated for budget savings

17.5 FTE's

Plus an additional loss of 7 FTE's

- » 2 Managers, 1 Captain, 1 Lieutenant (unfunded)
- » 1 Sr. Sheriff's Technician Civil (eliminated)
- » 4 Deputy Sheriff's*
- * this may be reinstated if COPS funding/grant is approved
- » Back to 2005-2006 staffing levels

2008-2009 OVERTIME REDUCTION

- Through the 3rd quarter reduced OT by 9,300 hours
- On target for a reduction of 12,000 OT hours by budget year end
- Optimistic that similar savings will continue into 2009-2010

2009-2010 We have absorbed/eliminated

- Loss of \$1.7 million from Prop 172
- Eliminated all General Fund Extra Help positions
- Reduction of \$1 million in services and supplies

\$975,000

in Casino related start-up costs

- \$750,000 Staffing
 - 6 Deputies, 1 Sergeant
- \$175,000 Equipment Training
- \$ 50,000+ to date, for Jail Booking & Housing costs

FUTURE CHALLENGES

- Furloughs
 - \$943,000 CAO imposed reduction
 - can only furlough 1/3 of the employees, Charter 504, 24/7
 - Per CAO's analysis, savings of \$174K through furloughs, the remainder \$769K through other means
- Loss of School Resource Officers
- CDC Prisoner Releases
- Wobblers Felonies vs. Misdemeanors
 - Impacts on County Jail
- Facilities
