Section 970 of the California Military and Veterans Code states:

"The board of supervisors of each county may appoint an officer to be titled "county veterans service officer." It shall be the duty of the county veterans service officer to:

- Administer the aid provided for in this chapter
- Investigate all claims, applications, or requests for aid,
- And to perform any other veteran related services as requested by the county board of supervisors."



Section 971 of the California Military and Veterans Code states:

"The county veteran service officer shall assist every veteran of any war of the United States and the dependents of every deceased veteran, in presenting and pursuing any claim the veteran may have against the United States and in establishing the veteran's right to any privilege, preference, care, or compensation provided for by the laws of the United States or of this state."



Section 972 of the California Military and Veterans Code states:

"The board of supervisors may provide the county veterans service officer with such assistants and facilities as it deems necessary."

- Managing the Department of Veteran Affairs


