The proposed grant budget for a HOME-funded application is outlined above. An Project under this allocation would be entirely funded by the \$4,100,000 HOME grant. The County has an established system that complies with OMB Circular A-87 to track actual time worked in specific grants, and allocates costs of wages and benefits to this funding source based on actual time worked. Other administrative costs to support the activities conducted under this grant, such as postage, office supplies and space costs are eligible grant expenditures and are included in the above proposed budget. Financial accomplishments and program activity

conducted under the guidelines of this grant program are monitored by staff and reported to the California Department of Housing and Community Development.

After the HOME grant term, County staff conducts ongoing annual project monitoring per the requirements established by the HOME Program for the period of affordability which is 55 years. The costs associated with the process are nominal and paid under the DHS General Fund dollars budgeted for Housing Element/Affordable Housing activities.
