Dear Ms. Ercolini:

Attached is a list of tribes that have cultural and traditional affiliation to Tulare County. **For upcoming projects, I suggest you contact all of those listed, if they cannot supply information they might recommend others with specific knowledge.** The list should provide a starting place to locate areas of potential adverse impact within an APE. By contacting all those on the list, your organization will be better able to respond to claims of failure to consult, as may be required under particular state statutes. If a response has not been received within two weeks of notification, the Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) requests that you follow-up with an email or telephone call to ensure that the project information has been received.

The NAHC also recommends that project proponents conduct a record search of the NAHC Sacred Lands File (SLF) and the appropriate regional archaeological Information Center of the California Historic Resources Information System (CHRIS) (http://ohp.parks.ca.gov/?page_id=1068) to determine if any tribal cultural resources are located within the area(s) affected by the proposed action. The SFL, established under Public Resources Code section 5094, contains sacred sites submitted for listing to the NAHC by California Native American tribes. The request form can be found at <http://nahc.ca.gov/resources/forms/>. **Please note records maintained by the NAHC and CHRIS is not exhaustive, and a negative response to these searches does not preclude the existence of tribal cultural resources.** A tribe may in fact be the only source for information about tribal cultural resources within an APE.

If you receive notification of change of addresses and phone numbers from any of these tribes, please notify me. With your assistance we are able to assure that our lists contain current information.
