

PROCLAMATION

Of the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado In Recognition of the Community Volunteers Who Support The El Dorado Elections Department as Election Precinct Officers

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Elections Department provides elections services to all county residents for federal, state, county, city, school and special district elections; and,

WHEREAS, each election the El Dorado County Registrar of Voters and the dedicated staff of the El Dorado County Elections Department are supported by the community volunteers who serve as Election Precinct Officers and by the El Dorado County youth who serve as Student Officers; and,

WHEREAS, Election Precinct Officers support election day operations at each of the polling places located throughout the County, ensuring that operations at each polling place run smoothly, beginning before the polling locations open at 7:00 am and well after they close at 8:00 pm; and,

WHEREAS, on election day, the Election Precinct Officers provide critical assistance at each polling location that includes the setup of equipment, voter assistance, voter sign-in, verification of voter qualifications, distribution of ballots, operation of voting equipment, completion of election forms, and the return of the voting equipment to the Elections Department; tireless work that ensures that the elections in El Dorado County are conducted as fair, honest and accurate

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado does hereby recognize the community volunteers who as Election Precinct Officers and as Student Officers support the El Dorado County Elections Department and in appreciation for their important work that ensures that the residents of El Dorado County have access to an election process that is honest, fair and accurate and operated at polling places that are safe and conveniently located.
