⁴The City of South Lake Take does not bank in the county treasury; we do not have details on their internal departmental budgets. The allocations of property taxes are made, in total, to the city without regard to specific function. The amount reflected in this schedule is the total property tax allocation not just an amount specific to fire. The budget figures taken from the city's web site show their general fund revenues for fire are only \$311,476; however, the general fund budget expenditures are \$4,459,518. There additional revenues of \$1,197,676 and expenditures of \$1,154,111 in their fire budget that come from non-general fund sources.
