### FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES #498-S1711

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to that Agreement for Services #498-S1711 made and entered into by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), and Nichols Consulting Engineers, Chtd., a Nevada corporation duly qualified to conduct business in the State of California, whose principal place of business is 1885 South Arlington Avenue, Suite 111, Reno, Nevada 89509, whose local office address is 155 Highway 50, Suite 204, Stateline, Nevada 89449, and whose mailing address is Post Office Box 1760, Zephyr Cove, Nevada 89448 (hereinafter referred to as "CONSULTANT");

### RECITALS

**WHEREAS**, Consultant has been engaged by County to provide environmental review services for the Department of Transportation, pursuant to Agreement for Services #498-S1711, dated June 6, 2017, incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement");

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend the Agreement to add additional Items of Work to the Scope of Work, amending ARTICLE I, Scope of Services, and adding Exhibit A-1, Additional Scope of Work;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend the Agreement to update the title of one of COUNTY's notice recipients, amending ARTICLE XXVII, Notice to Parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter contained, COUNTY and CONSULTANT mutually agree to amend the terms of the Agreement in this First Amendment to Agreement on the following terms and conditions:

- I. The First Recital of the Agreement is replaced in its entirety to read as follows:
  - WHEREAS, COUNTY has determined that it is necessary to obtain a consultant to assist its Department of Transportation with environmental, geotechnical, geological, hydraulic, hydrologic engineering support services, and other project delivery support services in the Tahoe Basin in conjunction with the Environmental Improvement Program (EIP);
- II. All references to Community Development Agency, Transportation Division, throughout the Agreement shall read Department of Transportation.

- III. All references to Exhibit A throughout the Agreement shall read Exhibit A and Exhibit A-1.
- IV. ARTICLE I, Scope of Services, paragraph one (1) of the Agreement is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

CONSULTANT agrees to furnish personnel, subconsultants, materials, equipment, and services necessary to perform environmental, geotechnical, geological, hydraulic, hydrologic engineering support services, and other project delivery support services generally including, but not be limited to, those tasks as identified in Exhibit A, marked "Scope of Work," and Exhibit A-1, marked "Additional Scope of Work," both exhibits incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof, or as identified in the individual Task Orders or Work Orders, as applicable, to be issued in accordance with this Agreement.

V. ARTICLE XXVII, Notice to Parties, is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

### **ARTICLE XXVII**

### Exhibit A-1

### Additional Scope of Work

CONSULTANT shall furnish personnel, subconsultants, materials, equipment, and services necessary to perform various on-call geotechnical, geological, hydraulic, and hydrologic engineering services.

- A. General geotechnical and geological services including, but not limited to:
  - Complete geotechnical engineering and consultation, including field investigation, geologic reconnaissance and field mapping, soil testing, sampling, soil drilling and borings, slope stability analysis, scour analysis, and preparation of draft and final reports.
  - Roadway structural section design recommendations, including core sampling and resistance "R" value tests and analysis.
  - Foundation investigations and recommendations for bridges, buildings, retaining walls, mechanically stabilized earth walls, and associated transportation structures.
  - Geotechnical or Material Analysis of structural (bridge, abutment, pier, footing, foundation, or retaining wall) elements.
  - Providing qualified and appropriate traffic control services as required for field work.
  - Stormwater sampling and testing, including assistance with required permits and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan preparation and implementation, in accordance with California Regional Water Quality Control Board and COUNTY Stormwater Management Plan's rules and regulations.
- B. General hydraulic and hydrologic engineering services including, but not limited to:
  - Hydraulic and hydrologic analysis, modeling, and design.

The actual number of issues addressed, level of service provided, and associated level of effort vary depending on the level of support requested or required by COUNTY as identified in each individual Task Order or Work Order issued by COUNTY's Contract Administrator.

COUNTY's Contract Administrator will issue a written Task Order for any work assignment where the not-to-exceed cost itemization is \$10,000 or greater. COUNTY's Contract Administrator will issue a written Work Order for any work assignment where the not-to-exceed cost itemization is less than \$10,000.

The deliverables shall be provided in hard copy and electronic format compatible with COUNTY's software requirements and in accordance with ARTICLE I, Scope of Services, as amended, of this Agreement.
