Tax Collection

- Secured and Unsecured Property Tax Bills
 - Tax bills mailed ~ 137,000
 - Tax payments processed ~ 263,000
 - Projected FY 18/19 property tax collections ~\$388 Million
 - Tax collections support vital local government services



Tax Collection (cont.)

- Over the last 3 fiscal years Transient Occupancy Taxes (TOT) have increased from \$3,191,000 to \$4,115,000
- FY 18/19 targeted collections
 - ~ \$4,900,000 \$5,000,000
- There are 1,012 licensed TOT filers who file 4,048 returns annually



Business Licenses

- County currently has 11,189 active business licenses
- Business licenses are renewed annually
- FY 18/19 business license revenue ≈ \$360,000



Revenue Recovery

- Pursue monies owed to the County
- Correspond and negotiate with debtors to settle accounts
- Annual discharge of accountability as prescribed by law

Additional FY 18/19 Service Highlights

- Assist ~ 30,000 walk-in customers at the counter
- Answer over 21,000 phone calls
- Receive and send over 20,000 letters and other correspondence (i.e. emails and faxes)
- Process over 10,000 deposits

FENIX – Megabyte - KRONOS

- To date, the FENIX implementation has gone well. No efficiencies have been identified
- The KRONOS implementation is going well. No efficiencies have been identified
- Megabyte implementation has been more challenging
- The department is analyzing what is new and what is needed
- The department is developing and documenting processes

Technology Goals

- Implement Megabyte TOT module (currently testing)
- Implement Megabyte Property Tax Sale module (not yet released for testing)
- Develop Cannabis Business License requirements
- Implement a Cannabis Tax System
- Automate returned mail (purchase of a new scanner)



On the Horizon - Cannabis

- Tax revenue will be generated
- Business license revenue will be generated
- A portion of the cannabis revenue may be earmarked for licensing, tax collection, banking activities, as well as security and equipment needs
