

3) We are very concerned about placing the sign on the property line as it puts our property at risk for vandalism since it is vacant between rentals. We beg you to reconsider this requirement. We have been renting our house for 15 years and have never been vandalized AND we have paid the County approx. \$20K in TOT taxes during this time frame. Should our property be vandalized due to this new requirement, we will likely stop renting our house which will be a loss of revenue to the County.

4) We are very concerned about posting our property address on the County Website as this puts our property at risk for vandalism since it is vacant between rentals. We do not reveal our address on any Websites. We beg you to reconsider this requirement. We have been renting our house for 15 years and have never been vandalized AND we have paid the County approx. \$20K in TOT taxes. Should our property be vandalized due to this new requirement, we will likely stop renting our house therefore there will be a loss of revenue to the County.

Our vacation home is in Somerset and sits in the middle of 5 acres with no houses/neighbors in the vicinity. There is no issue with parking, trash, noise, etc. Our vacation home should not be subject to the same ordinances as the vacation homes in more populated areas. We have been renting our house for 15 years and have not had any complaints and have the required health and safety measures in place. Your consideration would be appreciated.
