Hi Laura, Russ,

I have updated the 4217 resolution and agenda item for the 3/19 BOS meeting. Please review and let me know if you have any questions, there are a couple of names and resolution numbers to be added. Also attached the Exhibit A's for both sites that will be attached to the Resolution. These are not updated to show the final design changes and Power Price change (PPA rate) because we do not have the pricing impacts from REC Solar as of yet. Preliminary estimates from REC solar indicate a 3% increase in PPA rate to accommodate the 15 foot minimum clearance, lighting installation, 24 foot column spacing, and \$50k increase to Site Improvement Cost in the CRA.

RESOLUTION MAKING FINDINGS, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENTS, PERFORMANCE GUARANTEES AND COST REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH REC SOLAR COMMERCIAL CORPORATION, AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF OTHER DOCUMENTS, AND OTHER ACTIONS REQUIRED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State of California and the intent of the State Legislature to promote all feasible means of energy conservation and all feasible uses of alternative energy supply sources; and

WHEREAS. California Government Code Section 4217.10 et seq. authorizes a public agency to contract for energy services without going through a formal bid process if its governing body determines, at a regularly scheduled public hearing, public notice of which is given at least two weeks in advance, that the anticipated cost to the agency for the alternative energy project will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the agency of electrical energy that would have been consumed by the agency in the absence of the energy services contract; and

WHEREAS, County of El Dorado ("County") desires to <u>utilize a qualified contractor to design</u>, construct, install, own, operate, and maintain solar photovoltaic facilities located at the <u>Public Safety Facility parking lot and Public Safety Facility vacant land ("Solar Project") to reduce the steadily rising costs of meeting the energy needs at its facilities <u>and generate cost savings</u>; and</u>

WHEREAS, TerraVerde Energy, LLC ("TerraVerde"), has provided the County with analysis showing the benefits of implementing certain energy conservation measures through the installation of certain solar photovoltaic systems, and TerraVerde's analysis ("Analysis") is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made part hereof by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the County proposes to enter into a power purchase agreement and related eontract—documents—("Power Purchase Agreement") for each Solar Project site, a Cost Reimbursement Agreement, and a lease agreement with REC Solar Commercial Corporation ("REC Solar"), pursuant to which REC Solar will design, construct, install, own, maintain, and operate on County property certain energy saving improvements consisting of solar photovoltaic facilities—the Solar Project and arrange with the local utility for interconnection of the facilities, which will generate energy for the sites on which such facilities are located; and

WHEREAS, the sites where such solar photovoltaic facilities ("Project") will be located are: Public Safety Facility parking lot and Public Safety Facility open lot; and

WHEREAS, TerraVerde Energy, LLC ("TerraVerde"), has provided the County with analysis showing the benefits of implementing certain energy conservation measures through the installation of certain solar photovoltaic systems, and TerraVerde's analysis ("Analysis") is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made part hereof by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the Analysis includes data showing that the anticipated cost to the County for the electrical energy provided by the <u>Solar Project</u> will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the County of electrical energy that would have been consumed by the County in the absence of those purchases; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors County proposes to enter into the Power Purchase Agreement and Cost Reimbursement Agreement substantially in the form presented at this meeting, subject to such changes, insertions or omissions as the County's representative or their designee reasonably deems necessary following the Board's adoption of this Resolution provided such changes, insertions, or omissions do not change the price and term period of such agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County and REC Solar also contemplate entering into a lease agreement for the Solar Project site, which requires the consent and approval of the United States of America, acting through the Rural Housing Service ("USDA"), and County staff will return to the Board of Supervisors with the lease agreement after USDA approval; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 4217.12, the Board has held a public hearing, public notice of which was given at least two weeks in advance, to receive public comment; and

WHEREAS, the County's proposed approval of the Power Purchase Agreement whereby Company is required to perform the Project is a project for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"); and

WHEREAS, the Guidelines for CEQA, the Project is currently covered and discussed in the existing Environmental Impact Report ("EIR"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the above-referenced recitals, the Board hereby finds, determines and orders as follows:

- 1. The Board finds that the terms of the Power Purchase Agreement with REC Solar for each Solar Project site -are in the best interests of the County.
- 2. In accordance with Government Code section 4217.12, and based on data provided by the Analysis, the Board finds that the anticipated cost to the County for electrical energy provided by the Project under the Power Purchase Agreement will be less than the anticipated marginal cost to the County of electrical energy that would have been consumed by the County in the absence of those purchases.

Comment [A1]: Although GC 4217.1 appears to be intended for the public agency to make the necessary findings in one meeting, because we are doing a two-step process, the analysis and findings related to the lease agreement under subsection (a)(2) will need to be done at a later time.

Comment [A2]: CEQA discussion can be incorporated in the staff report. The solar farm and carport were analyzed and included in the EIR for the Public Safety Facility project. County consultant is reviewing if the selected RES-BCT option C is consistent with the EIR project description or will require an EIR Addendum.

- 3. The Board hereby approves and authorizes the Chair to execute the Power Purchase Agreement for each Solar Project site and Cost Reimbursement Agreement which shall be subject to such changes, insertions or omissions as the County's representative Chief Administrative Officer or their designee reasonably deems necessary provided such changes, insertions, or omissions do not change the price and term period of such agreement.
- 4. The County's representative or designee is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate any further changes, insertions and omissions to the Power Purchase Agreement as they reasonably deems necessary, and thereafter to execute and deliver the Power Purchase Agreement following the Board's adoption of this Resolution. The County's representative Chief Administrative Officer or designee is further authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all papers, instruments, opinions, certificates, affidavits and other documents and to do or cause to be done any and all other acts and things necessary or proper for carrying out this resolution and said agreements.
