PLEASE PUBLICLY POST THE ENTIRETY OF THIS CORRESPONDENCE TO ITEMS #2 AND #3 OF THE 4/25/19 PLANNING COMMISSION AGENDA.

Lori Parlin's admin, Shelley Wiley, approached me during last night's illegitimate <u>RMAC-River Mafia Mob meeting</u> held at the Coloma Grange Hall relevant to the purpose of this correspondence. I audio recorded our discussion(s) involving the county's <u>unlawful manipulations</u> and Lori Parlin's unethical conduct.

During the 3/18/19 meeting Lori announced that RMAC was <u>officially disbanded in 2018</u>. A committee that has already been disbanded can NOT continue to conduct meetings as required under the Brown Act, nor can RMAC lawfully take action and make recommendations. <u>Meanwhile Parks & Rec staff routinely act on their behalf by processing these two agenda items</u>.

However last night Lori changed her tune when she announced to the 23 attendees pictured below that RMAC <u>will be</u> disbanded upon approval of the RMAC resolution by the BOS. Lori Parlin, Sue Taylor and Kris Payne were instrumental in preparing the RMAC resolution during the illicit 2018 serial RMAC meetings. In other words, it was already predetermined behind closed doors in total contradiction to EDC Core Values and against all public policy.



Lori further explained the RMAC Resolution will enable the county to change the name from RMAC to CLAC (Coloma Lotus Advisory Committee) as outlined in her handouts specifically slides 34 through 41. This is simply a swap of names under the color of law to empower the River Mafia Mob. For over three decades these unscrupulous liberals have been notorious for their and harassment, threats and assaults to dissuade conservative SFAR residents from attending these meetings. Furthermore Lori emphatically stated that with the assistance of county counsel she will ensure the River Mafia Mob get ANYTHING THEY DESIRE—ANYTHING!!

The River Management Advisory Committee, Parks & Recreation and Planning Commissioners merely serve to organize faction, to give it an artificial and powerful force to put in place a small but enterprising minority of special interest rafting groups. As you are aware, any enterprise undertaken by any public official who tends to weaken public confidence and undermine the sense of security for individual rights is against public policy. Fraud, in its elementary common-law sense of deceit, is the simplest and clearest definition of that word. As such Lori's collusion with county staff to circumvent the law blatantly aids and abets the corrupt status quo with the full knowledge and support of the Planning Commission and the BOS.

The Planning Commission should not be taking any action on these two agenda items. First make it a priority to address the problem of government transparency and accountability before rubber-stamping the approval of any more river permits.
