**BYLAWS AMENDMENT PUBLICATION DATE: JUNE 18, 2019**

**Reviewed and Adopted Date:**

1. The name of the organization shall be the **El Dorado County Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Commission** (EDC JJDPC). (Juvenile Justice Commission and Delinquency Prevention Commission are combined into a single body).
2. Authority: California Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC):
  - a. Section 225 through 231 requires each county to have a Juvenile Justice Commission (JJC) to inquire into the administration of juvenile justice in their counties.
  - b. Section 232 through 236 provides for EDC Board of Supervisors to establish a Delinquency Prevention Commission (DPC) to coordinate the work of governmental and nongovernmental organizations engaged in activities designed to prevent juvenile delinquency.
3. All meetings and commission business are conducted in accordance with Brown Act provisions.
4. Officer roles are Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer and Secretary, elected biennially.
5. Standing committees:
  - a. Facility Inspections (led by Vice Chair)
  - b. Treasury (led by Treasurer)
  - c. Delinquency Prevention
  - d. Communications
  - e. Outreach
  - f. Education
6. Attendance policy allows up to 3 absences in a rolling twelve-month period, possibly resulting in resignation or Honorary Member status.
7. Approved projects are assigned to a temporary, dedicated committee for the life of that project.
8. Fundraising and fiduciary responsibilities are conducted per guidance from El Dorado County administration expert resources.
