By using these Tactics you are able to Throw everybody else out of the bid process and eliminate any competition to your local vendor. Also after further review of the Submitted bids our Bid Was the Lowest Bid before the Local vendor discount (GCR - \$128,824.15 / Sierra Nevada - \$145,900.70) and also after the discount (GCR - \$128,824.15 / Sierra Nevada - \$138605.67)
