Whereas, Terry Tawney began his career in Revenue and Taxation October of 1972 in San Joaquin County as a Real Property Appraiser; and,

Whereas, Terry Tawney was hired by the El Dorado County Assessor on May 6th, 1978 as the Standards Control Evaluator; and,

Whereas, Terry Tawney supervised the development the Assessor's Computerized Property System (M204); and,

Whereas, Terry Tawney executed the conversion to the Proposition 13 system of reappraisal in 1978 from a cyclical reappraisal system; and

Whereas, Terry Tawney served as the legislative analyst for the Assessor's Office; and,

Whereas, Terry Tawney represented his fellow employees on the Board of Directors for the El Dorado County Employees' Association, Local #1; and

Whereas, Terry Tawney also served as the liason for interagency coordination of El Dorado County Assessor's Master Property System; and,

Whereas, Terry Tawney, as Senior Information Technology Department Coordinator, has one of the longest job titles in El Dorado County,

Now, Therefore, Be It Proclaimed, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado does hereby recognize and appreciate the dedicated service of Terry Tawney, which has contibuted greatly to the betterment of the people and community in El Dorado County.
