



RESOLUTION NO. 135-2019

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville and El Dorado County continue to work together for the benefit of our community; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code §25551, the City Council of the City of Placerville on June 11, 2019 adopted Resolution No. 8752 finding that 88% of the users of the Placerville Aquatic Center are County residents who reside outside the City limits, and requesting assistance from the County in the amount of \$20,000 for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 to offset some of the increased maintenance and operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive aquatics program during the summer months; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code §25553, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors finds that the maintenance and operational costs for the Placerville Aquatic Center are increased by reason of use by a large number of County residents who reside outside the City limits, and desires to extend aid to the City in the amount of \$20,000 for Fiscal Year 2019/2020, and any subsequent funding to be subject to budgetary review and Board of Supervisors approval each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code §25556, this aid shall be used by the City of Placerville within one year from the time it is extended by the County and any sum or property remaining at the end of the year shall be returned to the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code §25558, a report showing the disposition of the aid shall be made by the City to the Board of Supervisors within one year from the time it is received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors extends aid in the amount of \$20,000 for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 to the City of Placerville to offset the increased maintenance and operational costs associated with the use of the Placerville Aquatic Center by a large number of County residents who reside outside the City limits and participate in the aquatics program.
