NOTICE OF VACANCY

EL DORADO COUNTY EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION PLANNING COUNCIL

ONE (1) VACANCY EXISTS ON THE EL DORADO COUNTY EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION PLANNING COUNCIL FOR (1) COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVE, WHICH IS A PERSON WHO REPRESENTS AN AGENCY OR BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES PRIVATE FUNDING FOR CHILD CARE SERVICES, OR WHO ADVOCATES FOR CHILD CARE SERVICES THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN CIVIC OR COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS BUT IS NOT A CHILD CARE PROVIDER AND DOES NOT REPRESENT AN AGENCY THAT CONTRACTS WITH CDE TO PROVIDE CHILD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES.

TWO (2) VACANCIES *MAY* EXIST FOR **(1) FOR A PUBLIC AGENCY REPRESENTATIVE**, WHICH IS A PERSON WHO REPRESENTS A CITY, COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY AND **(1) FOR A DESIGNEE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**, WHICH IS ANY OF THE CATEGORIES OR OUT OF THE CATEGORIES OUTLINED IN THE BYLAWS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

Description: The fifteen member Council is a legislatively mandated body advising the County Board of Supervisors (BOS) and County Superintendent of Schools on early care and education program and policy issues. The Council provides input on research and analysis, makes recommendations to the California Department of Education on funding priorities for subsidized child care and development programs, and coordinates countywide early care and education projects.

Successful applicants would be those who are concerned about and/or experienced with child care and early education issues.

Applicants must submit cover sheet, BOS committee application, and supplemental application to Elizabeth Blakemore, M.Ed., Coordinator, Early Care and Education Planning Council, 6767 Green Valley Road, Placerville, CA 95667.
