PROVIDE PUBLIC ACCESS TO INFORMATION ABOUT MEETING ROOMS

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

BOARD APPOINTED BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES

COUNTY DEPARTMENTS

GROUPS FORMED OR AUTHORIZED BY COUNTY DEPARTMENTS TO SUPPORT COUNTY SERVICES OR PROGRAMS

COUNTY EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATIONS

Who Can Use Meeting Rooms? Non-County Government

AGENCIES AND OFFICERS OF FEDERAL, STATE OR OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FOR GOVERNMENT FUNCTIONS

Who Can Use Meeting Rooms? Non-Government Organizations & Groups

GROUPS CAN USE MEETING ROOMS FOR PROGRAMS OR ACTIVITIES OF CIVIC, CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL, OR COMMUNITY INTEREST.

MEETINGS OF PUBLIC GROUPS MUST BE DURING COUNTY REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS

MEETINGS OF PUBLIC GROUPS ARE RESTRICTED TO THESE FACILITIES:

SOUTH LAKE TAHOE LIBRARY
PLACERVILLE (MAIN) LIBRARY
CAMERON PARK LIBRARY
EL DORADO HILLS LIBRARY

How Can Meeting Rooms Be Used? Non-Government Organizations & Groups

- A) MEETINGS MUST BE FOR A NON-COMMERCIAL PURPOSE
- B) POLITICAL ACTIVITIES ADVOCATING OR OPPOSING SPECIFIC BALLOT ISSUES OR CANDIDATES ARE PROHIBITED
- C) MEETING ROOM APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT IS REQUIRED

How Can Meeting Rooms be Used? Non-Government Organizations & Groups

D) APPLICANT MUST BE 18 OR OLDER AND PRESENT AT THE MEETING

- E) PUBLICITY MUST NOT IMPLY ENDORSEMENT OF THE COUNTY
- F) COUNTY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL MEETINGS IF THE ROOM IS NEEDED FOR COUNTY BUSINESS.
