



**RESOLUTION NO. 212-2019**  
**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO**

**WHEREAS**, Section 29321 of the California Government Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish a revolving fund for the use of any Officer of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors by Resolution 123-2015, authorized the the Health and Human Services Agency to establish an imprest cash account in the amount of \$100 for the facilitation of normal Emergency Medical Services Agency business; and


**WHEREAS**, effective July 1, 2019, the Emergency Medical Services program has been transferred from the Health and Human Services Agency to the Chief Administrative Office; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the County of El Dorado Board of Supervisors hereby transfers responsibility of the imprest account in the amount of \$100 for the facilitation of normal Emergency Medical Services business established in Resolution 123-2015 from the Health and Human Services Agency to the Chief Administrative Office. The County Officer or employee with responsibility for administering this account is Michelle Patterson, Emergency Medical Services Agency Manager, or successor
