SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE ORDINANCE NO. 5116

The proposed ordinance amends Chapter 3.13, titled Contracting Out, to clarify requirements for entering into contracts for the performance of work by independent contractors and align them more closely to County Charter section 210(b)(6). The amendment includes specifying the eight criteria allowing for the use of independent contractors, requiring written findings for entering into such contracts, deleting Section 3.13.040 and incorporating it to Section 3.13.030, and renumbering Section 3.13.050. Adoption of this ordinance will be heard by the Board of Supervisors on December 17, 2019, in the Board Meeting Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California, A full and complete copy of the full text of the proposed ordinance is available for viewing in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California, This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days following the adoption thereof. 12/11 7207
