AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES #4106 AMENDMENT I

This First Amendment to that Agreement for Services #4106, is made and entered into by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "County") and The Center for Common Concerns, Inc., HomeBase, a non-profit organization, duly qualified to conduct business in the State of California, whose principal place of business is 870 Market Street, Suite 1228, San Francisco, CA 94102-2926, (hereinafter referred to as "Consultant");

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Contractor has been engaged by County to provide strategic and practical technical assistance, informed by national best-and-emerging practices, to the community collaborative known as El Dorado Opportunity Knocks Continuum of Care (CoC) in accordance with Agreement for Services #4106, dated August 28, 2019, incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have mutually agreed to extend the term and increase the total amount of said Agreement, hereby amending Article II – "Term," and Article III - "Compensation for Services."

NOW THEREFORE, the parties do hereby agree that Agreement for Services #4106 shall be amended a first time as follows:

1) ARTICLE II – Term is hereby amended and replaced in its entirety to read as follows:

ARTICLE II

Term: This Agreement shall become effective upon the date of final execution by all parties hereto and shall cover the period of September 25, 2019 through December 31, 2020, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the provisions contained herein this Agreement under the Article(s) titled "Default, Termination, and Cancellation" or "Fiscal Considerations."

// // 2) ARTICLE III – Compensation for Services is hereby amended and replaced in its entirety to read as follows:

ARTICLE III

Compensation for Services: For services provided herein, including any deliverables that may be identified herein, County agrees to pay Consultant upon the satisfactory completion and County's acceptance of work, monthly in arrears and within forty-five (45) days following the County's receipt and approval of itemized invoice(s) identifying services rendered.

Total amount of this Agreement shall not exceed \$127,000.00.
