What is HotlinePOST?

The Hotline Poster Outreach to Stop Trafficking (HotlinePOST) campaign is based on a California law (Civil Code section 52.6) that requires certain categories of businesses to display a poster that informs human trafficking survivors and the public about human trafficking. The poster includes a national toll free number that human trafficking survivors can call or text to get help. The public can also call this hotline if they have questions or suspect that human trafficking may be occurring.

How can I get a copy of the poster?

In 2014, several Sacramento County anti-trafficking organizations worked with human trafficking survivors to design a poster that complies with Civil Code section 52.6. You can download the current version of the poster at bit.ly/2020HotlinePOSTposter. To comply with the law, the finished (cropped) poster must be at least at least 11" x 14".

What happens during a HotlinePOST community day of action?

During a HotlinePOST community day of action, community members attend a morning of training on human trafficking and the posting law, and then visit assigned locations in teams to inform local businesses about the law and to encourage posting of the Sacramento County version of the notice.
