# Fiscal Division

## Main Duties Include

  - Grant Management
    - *State Grant Awards: 8*
    - *Federal Grant Awards: 7*
  - Procurement, Contracts and Inventory
  - FEMA Reimbursement Liaison
  - Legislative Analysis
- Fiscal is Staffed with 10 FTE
    - *CFO, Sr. Admin Analyst, Analysts, Admin Techs, Fiscal Techs, and Fiscal Assistant.*

# Support Services Staffing Allocation

- 71 FTE
  - *Captain, Lieutenant, Sergeants, Deputy Sheriffs, Dispatchers and Sheriff Techs*



# Fun Facts from Support Services in 2019

- Records processed 1690 RO, an increase of 17%, and 6327 Warrants
- Fingerprinted 2581 people (or 25,810 fingers)
- Issued / Renewed 2164 CCWs
- Coroners completed 530 death investigation with the average age being 68.1
- On average a Deputy trains 35 hours a year (POST requires 24 hours every two years)
- Dispatch received, on average 85 9-1-1 calls per day in 2019, for a total of around 93K
- STARS donated just over 22K hours last year and participated in 46 Community Events

# Custody Staffing Allocation

- 154 FTE
  - *Captain, Lieutenants, Sworn and non-Sworn Sergeants, Correctional Officers, Deputy Sheriffs, Security Officers, Sheriff Techs, Detention Aids and Cooks*
- Operate Jails in Placerville and SLT





# 2019 Custody Stats

- Jail's average Daily Population (ADP) in 2019 was 394
- Placerville Jail Capacity is 303
- SLT Jail Capacity is 158
  - *461 Total beds*
- The jail averaged 15 bookings per day in 2019. (5,669 total)
  - *Felony 2,199*
  - *Misd. 3,470*
- 107 Incidents of drugs and paraphernalia being found
- Eight incidents of battery against staff
- In custody program which are offered include:
  - *Culinary Arts*
  - *GED/Diploma*
  - *Anger Management*
  - *Parenting classes*

# SB 844

**SB 844 is a ~25 million grant funded addition to the Placerville Jail**

- *Approved in 2017, to increase programing space, medical and mental health housing, and allow for a female only section*
- *Program will also address ADA issues in the jail such as wider medical cells, and proper height of toilets and sinks*
- *Add workspace for Probation, Health and Human Services and other partners who provide services to inmates*

Documents are with Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) for review and approval.

The next steps are: 1) Request for Qualification, 2) Request for Proposal, 3) Design build phase

Estimated start date for construction: **Spring of 2021**

# Operations Staffing Allocation

- 137 FTE
  - *Captain, Lieutenants, Sergeants, Detectives, Deputies, Crime Analyst, and Sheriff Techs*
- Operate Offices out of Placerville and SLT



# Information about Operations in 2019

- Total No. of CFS that required a response: 59,533
  - *17,840 were self initiated*
  - *Averaged 163.1 a day*
- SROs in every High School and one in JR. High SRO (6 Total, 4 on Grants)
- About 3K cases passed through Investigations 2019.
  - *4 Homicides*
  - *9 Suspicious death investigations*
  - *377 Sex Cases*
- Narcotics Unit Wrote and Serviced over 60 SW and made 92 arrests
  - *12.2 lbs. of Meth*
  - *13,000 lbs. of processed MJ*
  - *19,800 MJ Plants*
  - *Seven BHO Labs*
- 2019 Search and Rescue Deployments
  - *West Slope: 35*
  - *SLT: 58*

# Operations Cont.

- 961 hours were spent patrolling the Rubicon Trail (or 96, 10 hour days)
  - *Contacted Appx. 10,905 trail users*
  - *Issued Appx. 99 Warnings and 15 citations (Crashed no Jeeps)*
- Boating Unit consists of six boats
  - *Assisted 344 people and 105 Vessels*
  - *Issued 292 Citations and 1,045 Warnings*
  - *Completed 79 Boating Inspections*
- Psychiatric Emergency Response Team
  - *Completed 27 W&I 5150 holds*
  - *Completed 405 Safety Plans*
- Homeless Outreach Team (HOT)
  - *Housed 170 Individuals*
  - *Inception there were 316*
    - *Of 316, only 24 remain*
  - *Currently have 40 known Homeless individuals in County*
