

## RESOLUTION NO.

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

## TO APPROVE HIGHWAY RESTRICTIONS FOR THE 29<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL AMERICA'S MOST BEAUTIFUL BIKE RIDE SUNDAY, JUNE 7, 2020

WHEREAS, TGFT Productions/Bike the West/Lake Tahoe Bicycle Coalition/Leukemia and Lymphoma Society of America proposes to conduct The 29<sup>th</sup> Annual America's Most Beautiful Bike Ride; and

**WHEREAS**, the 29<sup>th</sup> Annual America's Most Beautiful Bike Ride will temporarily impede and restrict the free passage of traffic over State Highway Routes 50 and 89 on Sunday, June 7, 2020, between Stateline through South Lake Tahoe between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.; and with the approval of Cal Trans and the California Highway Patrol, close northbound Emerald Bay Road (Hwy 89) to vehicular traffic, to allow bicycle participants and emergency vehicles only from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado County approves and consents to the proposed 29<sup>th</sup> Annual America's Most Beautiful Bike Ride and recommends approval of the consents to the proposed restriction of State Highway Routes 50 and 89 and closure of Highway 89 from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m., upon terms and conditions deemed appropriate and necessary by the State of California, Department of Transportation.
