### Proclaiming April 12-18, 2020 as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in El Dorado County

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our Sheriff Deputies by monitoring their activities via radio, providing them information and insuring their safety; and

**WHEREAS**, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the Board of Supervisors of El Dorado County do hereby proclaim April 12-18, 2020 as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in El Dorado County, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our county and citizens safe.
