## Funding for Broadband Pilot Projects

I am asking again that you include the Greenstone Country development in the "Priority Areas" for the Broadband Pilot Project development. Our community has approximately 345 residential parcels with very hilly terrain. This makes it difficult to receive anything close to Broadband via microwave dish for only a few parcels. AT&T will not connect DSL and Comcast does not have service in this area.

A fiber optic line currently runs through the middle of our community on the main road utilizing overhead lines (power poles). All that would be required is to run additional lines off the main artery line to the side streets. This would be <u>very inexpensive</u> as very little engineering would be needed, no digging is required, and the main fiber optic line is already in place!

This represents <u>the biggest bang for your buck</u> and would be far lower cost per parcel than the lowest of the areas currently being considered (Rescue at \$6,316 per home for 390 homes).
