










Current Economic Clusters \$5.1 Billion Regional Economy

Connected Tahoe

 Dig Once Policy language agreed to by Broadband Subcommittee – including Internet Service Providers, jurisdictions and local agencies. El Dorado County led all the CA local jurisdictions by adopting a Dig Once Policy last year.

- •Completed the Measuring for Prosperity Report – the only compilation of Tahoe specific community and economic indicators for the region.
- •20 indicators tracked and analyzed for trends since 2010 to present.
- •The 2017 Report also updated the Lake Tahoe Basin Economic Clusters for the first time since 2010.




Next Steps
