Dear Mr. Stanton,

Pursuant to Appendix D of the El Dorado Disposal Service Franchise Agreement, dated October 21st, 2014, we are requesting an interim year rate adjustment to all services provided by El Dorado Disposal Services (EDDS) in Areas A, B and C, as well as the WERS (MRF) Facility. The calculated rate adjustment is based on 85% of the annual percentage change in the CPI, All Urban Consumers, U.S. City Average – Garbage and Trash Collection, for the prior December to December (2018 to 2019) twelve-month period. Per the 'Agreement', we are requesting an increase of 1% effective July 1st, 2020, which is the 'floor' increase per the rate-making manual. 85% of the calculated index change is 0.14%. We have attached copies of the Detailed CPI reports in addition to the Interim Year Rate Application.

In addition to our request above, we would like to have a discussion with you regarding some additional rate changes related to the further decline in the commodity markets as well as the cost related to the construction of the new Transfer Station/Recycling Facility which serves all Western Slope customers. Roughly one month ago, our thought was to present these requests under the "Unforeseen Circumstances" clause in the Solid Waste Rate Setting Policies and Procedures Manual, Section C 6, page 1-5 simultaneously with our normal annual CPI request. However, in light of the current environment we would like the opportunity to seek and hopefully implement these additional increases sometime later in 2020. Again, request on this piece is to begin the conversation.
