Letter to Members of the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission

Ref: Central El Dorado Hills Specific Plan - Serrano Westside

I write to object to the rezoning Parker Development Company has requested referred to as the Serrano Westside. It will considerably change the feel of El Dorado Hills with thousands of people and cars causing massive congestion issues. I chose to buy and live in El Dorado Hills because of the open space.

We have plenty of housing in El Dorado Hills and the surrounding area occurring now and more is the planning stages: Parker is developing off Bass Lake Road, they have massive plans for Marble Valley. There also extensive housing being built at Hawk View at Bass Lake Hills, in Blackstone, Saratoga Estates, High Rise Apartments in Town Center, Heritage Estates senior housing off Latrobe, other senior living and memory care and more!

Years ago our Planning Commission together with the approval of the Board of Supervisors established an area of open space on both sides of Serrano Parkway that was to be originally a public golf course.
