

RESOLUTION NO. 145-2020

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, in November 2016, California voters approved Proposition 56 which increased the excise tax for tobacco products sold in the State; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$4,350,000 of the projected tobacco sales revenue will be allocated for distribution to local law enforcement agencies via a grant program in conjunction with the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Food and Drug Branch (FDB), Tobacco Enforcement Section (TES)/Stop Tobacco Access to Kids Enforcement Program (STAKE); and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Sheriff's Office applied and was awarded a grant to undertake a project designated to assist and participate in developing strategies to prevent and further curtail the illegal sale and marketing of tobacco products to minors to improve overall oral health for Californians;
