



AB 2083 (Chapter 815, Statutes of 2018) requires each county to develop and implement a memorandum of understanding (MOU) setting forth roles and responsibilities of agencies and other entities that serve children and youth in foster care who have experienced severe trauma.

Purpose of AB 2083

- To ensure that children and youth in foster care receive coordinated, timely, and trauma-informed services.
- Address systemic barriers to the traditional provision of interagency services.
- Support the structure and processes of each partner agency.
- Provide a framework that will guide the operations, activities, decisions and direction of the partner agency employees regarding children, youth and families.


Requirements of MOU

- Establishment and Operation of an Interagency Leadership Team (ILT)
- Commitment to implementation of Integrated Core Practice Model (ICPM)
- Information and Data Sharing Agreements
- Processes for Screening, Assessment, & Entry to Care
- Processes for Child and Family Teaming and Universal Service Planning

Requirements of MOU (cont'd)

- Establishment and operation of an Interagency Placement Committee
- Alignment and Coordination of Transportation and other Foster Youth Services
- Staff Recruitment, Training, and Coaching
- Financial Resource Management
- Development of Dispute Resolution Process
- Recruitment and Management of Resource Families and Delivery of Therapeutic Foster Care Services





- Made up of leaders from programs and departments that interact with children


Interagency Leadership Team (ILT) Ensures coordinated, timely, and traumainformed services are provided to children & youth in foster care who have experienced severe trauma




- Ensures coordinated, timely, and trauma-informed services are provided to children & youth in foster care who have experienced severe trauma
- Ensures foster children, youth, & families receive services needed to achieve safety, permanency, well being, and to allow them to live in the leastrestrictive environment that meets their needs




