This letter is to confirm that the California's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) intends to fund the County of El Dorado, District Attorney's Office, \$202,545 with a required match of \$67,515 for the VV Program. The total project cost is \$270,060.

The 12-month funding cycle will begin on January 1, 2021, and will end December 31, 2021. Once the Application is approved, you will receive a formal letter of grant award approval.

Once you are notified that you are in grant award, you may bill for expenses retroactively to January 1, 2021, the original start date of your new performance period.
