- The County shall offer at least one (1) Access and Linkage to Treatment Program

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### Access and Linkage to Treatment Programs

- Evaluation:
  - Number of referrals to treatment and the kind of treatment to which referred
  - Number of persons who followed through on the referral and engaged in treatment
  - Duration of untreated mental illness
  - Interval between the referral and engagement in treatment
  - Counties may use random sampling method

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
