

### Project Background

- Project considered by the Planning Commission on May 28, 2020. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was adopted and the design review permit for the project was approved.
- An Appeal to the Board of Supervisors was heard on July 14, 2020. The Board vacated the approval and directed staff to prepare a focused Environmental Impact Report (EIR).
- The 30-day Notice of Preparation (NOP) for the EIR was released on September 22, 2020.
- The Draft EIR was released for a 45-day public review on January 7, 2021 (SCH# 2020049050).

### **Project Description**

- 9,100 SF commercial retail building on a vacant 1.68acre site.
- Access via Northside Drive; 31 parking spaces.
- Landscaping would preserve two mature oak trees and add additional landscaping trees, shrubs, and groundcover.
- Monument sign located at northwest corner of property.
- Water provided by Georgetown Divide P.U.D.; on-site septic system. On-site stormwater retention/water quality features with a connection to the public storm 5 drain.


## **Planning Entitlements**

- Site is zoned General Commercial-Design Control (CG-DC).
- General Plan designation of Commercial.
- Retail use is allowed by right.
- Required approvals:
  - -Certification of the Final EIR.
  - -Approval of the Design Review

     Resources, Cultural Resources, Energy,
     Geology, Greenhouse Gas Emissions,
     Hazardous Materials, Hydrology, Land Use,
     Public Services (Safety) and Utilities,
     Transportation, Wildfire, Urban Decay

### **Environmental Impacts**

- Three potentially significant impacts
  - –Air Quality
  - -Biological Resources
  - -Cultural Resources
- Standard mitigation measures would reduce impacts to less than significant
