Hi Ray,

I have heard that the BOS has agendized the issue of rescinding the current California Fire Code adoption, with the local amendments. I also understand the main reason for this is that a developer group is pushing for a more narrow road standard (18 feet from the current adopted 20). I am completely apposed to changing (watering down) the current ordinance. The standard fire engine is 10' wide, mirror to mirror. If the roads were allowed to be any narrower than 20' wide, the engines would not be able to meet and pass each other on the road. In an Angora Fire situation, this would not only put the residents, but also the firefighters in grave danger.
