WHEREAS, protecting the general welfare and rights of all our citizen, regardless of age, ethnicity, abilities, sexual orientation, gender identity, or religion is part of El Dorado County and our nation's democratic ideals; and

WHEREAS, we are stronger as a community and a nation when we pursue equal rights and justice for all and act in ways that are tolerant, inclusive, and do not harm others.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado, per the preamble of the United States Constitution, will promote the general welfare by ensuring that all members of the County and its communities have a right to be treated with dignity and respect. That all members of the County deserve equal protection and justice under the law. That all members of the County feel safe and secure. That all members of the County are welcome to participate in the democracy we protect and cherish in the United States of America.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors will actively encourage and pursue mechanisms to improve understanding, dialogue and tolerance within our county and its communities.


